Greetings in the name of Jesus Christ! I would like to take this moment to address this Pandemic crisis COVID-19 and how we as a congregation are continuing to thrive in the midst. We ultimately believe that in the sovereignty of God as Psalm 24:1 reminds us, "The earth is the Lord's, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein". So, our responsibility as children of God is to trust in our Lord and Savior as the one who can heal all matters of disease. During this time, we encourage you to maintain a level of faith because its during these times when questioning the will and necessity of God factors into our walk.
